The Register has been updated to reflect all commitments offered throughout the House of Commons and House of Lords Select Committee stages.

The Register is formally held by the Department for Transport. The nominated undertaker (the name for the company or companies appointed by the Secretary of State for Transport to construct and maintain HS2) will be contractually obliged to comply with the Register.
