Early Civils Work 2 (ECW2) Overview

Highways Improvement Works

- Improving construction traffic routes at 20 locations
- Yarnfield lane diversion across a new bridge over MP with slip roads
- Surveys, scheme design, consents and detailed design
- Completed by December
 2024 ahead of main works

Route-wide Engineering Surveys

- Informing advanced and main civils scheme design
- Topo (LIDAR) GPR surveys, minor watercourse surveys, pre-demolition surveys
- Completed by April 2022 to issue to Advances and main civil works.

Route-wide Environmental Surveys

- Informing both advanced and main civils works scheme design.
- Ecological surveys, agricultural (soils) surveys, heritage surveys, hydrological (water) surveys, air quality monitoring.
- Completed by March 2023

Surveys

The first surveys to be undertaken are GPR and topographical surveys at 21 highway improvement sites and 20 route wide areas

Ground Penetrating Radar surveys:

- Started November 2021
- Completed June 2022

Topographical surveys:

- Started November 2021
- Completed June 2022
- Further drone surveys in wooded areas









Survey progress

- We will now look to complete further highway investigation such as bore holes and trial pits to better inform our design.
- We will complete these surveys between November 2022 – April 2023
- Mixture of closures and temporary traffic lights depending on location
- Mixture of day and night time working depending on location
- We will update local communities at least 14 days before any work begins









Supplementary traffic calming and road safety measures

All proposed additional measures will be delivered ahead of HS2 main construction work, subject to passing a Road Safety Audit and the necessary approvals from the local highways authority.

- 1 A51 speed gateway upgrade
- 2 Access only sign for Bearstone Road.
- 3 Convex mirror for exit at Pipe Gate onto A51.
- 4 Signage for HS2 HGV traffic to avoid slip road in Pipe Gate alongside A51.
- 5 New uncontrolled pedestrian crossing at Pipe Gate.
- 6 Access only sign for Gravenhunger Lane.
- 7 Additional measures to enhance crossing on A525 near school bus drop off such as a potential new crossing or further signage.
- 8 A525 speed gateway upgrade including features such as anti-skid red coloured surfaces, additional dragons teeth markings, speed limit roundels, no overtaking signs and speed limit signage.
- 9 Access only sign for Gravenhunger Lane.
- 10 Access only sign for Cherry Tree Lane.
- 11 Access only sign for Candle Lane.


Supplementary traffic calming and road safety measures

- 12 A51 speed gateway upgrade including features such as anti-skid red coloured surfaces, additional dragons teeth markings, speed limit roundels, no overtaking signs and speed limit signage.
- 13 Removal and cutting back of hedge at highway boundary (near Falcon Inn) to improve footway provision.
- 14 Upgrade of existing uncontrolled crossing point to zebra and relocation away from modified junction.
- 15 Upgrade to crossing outside school and enhancement of existing signage with school roundel markings and Crossing Patrol Officer (in agreement with council) during school drop off and pick up.
- 16 Five Vehicle Activated Signs along A51 in Woore, with two of these being larger and showing more information.
- 17 Anti-skid coloured surfacing and "Slow" text road marking on the A51 southbound approach to the A51/A525 junction
